**Facts about Haitian babies and our philosophies about placing children with families. Please read this before you answer the question about child desired.**

- 1. Newborn babies in Haiti are very fragile. Some die even when given the best care we can give them. They just don't have resistance to disease.**
- 2. Even older children can get an illness here and not survive but most older children have more resistance to the common illnesses in Haiti.**
- 3. Girls are requested more than boys. So sometimes there is a 2 to 4 month wait for girls.**
- 4. Haitian children up to the age of two are still babies. Most don't start walking until they are 15 to 18 months. They aren't talking yet and still are totally dependant on us to give them their care. Haitian children just aren't as mature as children in more developed countries.**
- 5. We've never had bonding issues with children Newborn to 5 years old. If they can bond with us, they can transfer that bonding process to you and your family. The problem with bonding comes from children who have never bonded or did not have their needs met. Our children are well loved.**
- 6. Because children, Newborn to 12 months, are less available for adoption, we will try to place these babies first with parents who have not had previous children.**
- 7. Sibling groups are usually 6 to 18 months and the other child 3 to 5 years old. We very seldom have a newborn and then a 2 year old.**
- 8. Keep your heart and mind open to maybe taking a child that is not what the social workers would think of as the "perfect adoptive child".**
  - a. Those children over 2 years old.**
  - b. Those that have some developmental delays that are not severe.**
  - c. The child that has a physical handicapped such as a cleft lip or palate that can be repaired with surgery.**
