As for Haiti, it was highlighted in the November 2008 issue of *Christianity Today* as being 1 of 35 nations currently faced with severe malnutrition, food shortfalls, and huge price strikes. Unfortunately, Haiti is in a famine with no expected change in 2009. Did you know that 75% of Haitians income goes to purchase food? The average Haitian worker earns less than \$2 dollars a day making it very difficult to buy food because their prices are equal to that in the United States.

For God's Littlest Angels, 2008 has been the year of obeying God's will. With the recent disasters in Haiti, we feel more than ever the urgency to keep orphans safe in our community. As many of you know, Haiti was hit by four hurricanes in August and September killing many villagers and destroying crops throughout the country. Then a Haitian school collapsed in early November killing approximately 90 children and injuring many more. Please keep those affected by these tragedies in your prayers as they desperately need comfort from our Lord. We thank God for you daily as your support to GLA keeps our children safe and gives hope that they will live a long life of happiness.



During the year God's Littlest Angels served 400 children and families in Haiti by providing food, healthcare, shelter and love. God's Littlest Angels also placed 150 children with caring adoptive families. A little 2-year old boy, *Djemy*, was so malnourished when he came to the orphanage, we were unsure if he would live. We are proud to share Djemy walked and ran for the first time this year! *Again, with your support we were able to provide proper healthcare, food and shelter to this precious child and without you he would not have lived.*
