Neonatal Intensive Care Unit

God's Littlest Angels runs a Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and we are able to provide life saving medical care for infants and toddlers, not readily available in many of the hospitals and clinics in our area.

God's Littlest Angels NICU has saved many lives, reunited many healed children with their birth families and united many children with their "forever adoptive families". Our wonderful nursery staff give our children the love and attention they so need and crave, helping them to develop and grow.

Orphanage / Adoptions

There are many unfortunate situations in Haiti where birth parents are unable to provide for their children.
